HOW WE PROTECT YOUR DATA:

We protect our members data in compliance with the GDPR Privacy Laws of 2018. The data we hold is restricted solely to contact information required to process club membership and contact members with information in regard to club activities. This consists of membership number, name and address, telephone number (where provided) and e-mail address plus, for junior members, date of birth.

Additionally the last payment date and expiry date are recorded. Members can opt out at any time by contacting the club secretary.

Members can request what details the club holds about them at any time. Records of members contact information are held by the Club Secretary and Treasurer on secure computer systems.

Contact information is held only as long as a member continues to pay their subscription. If this should lapse members will be given a reminder to renew. Should they decide to discontinue membership their details will be removed from our database.

Members will be requested to confirm that their contact information is correct each year when they renew their membership and consent to us holding it. The club does not retain any financial information that might be given to it in regard to membership renewals.

BLUE BADGE HOLDERS:

At Chingford Plain we currently have permission for a single blue badge holder to be parked on site. If you are a blue badge holder please notify us if you think you may wish to have access. Write your registration number in the box below:

For those new to our hobby you may be unaware of some of the recent changes introduced by the CAA which have a direct impact on our hobby.

In November 2019 the CAA introduced a scheme called the 'Drone and Model Aircraft Registration and Education Scheme' to regulate the flying of unmanned aircraft in the UK. As part of the scheme, owners of unmanned aircraft including fixed wing aircraft, multi rotors, helicopters and drones weighing between 250g and 20kg must register for an 'Operator ID' with the CAA.

There is a further requirement for any flyer without a recognised 'achievement' to register for an additional 'Flyer ID'.

OPERATOR ID

Adult members: Anyone over 18 years old, responsible for a drone or unmanned aircraft (weighing between 250g and 20kg (flying outdoors) must register as an operator and get an **Operator ID**. This is a £9 fee payable to the CAA unless you have instructed CMFC to pay this on your behalf.

Junior members: Under 18 year olds do not pay the **Operator ID** fee. Instead, their parent/guardian must register for an **Operator ID** on their behalf with the CAA and pay the fee.

If the parent or guardian is also a model flyer and has an existing **Operator ID**, the under 18yo can fly using their parent or guardian's ID. The under 18yo must still do an online test for their **flyer ID** if they do not have a minimum qualifying 'A' certificate.

FLYER ID

Adult members & junior members over the age of 13: If you have a recognised achievement like an 'A' certificate you do not need a **flyer ID**. Otherwise you do need a **flyer ID**. You can get this by completing a simple online competency test (<https://register-drones.caa.co.uk/individual>).

Junior members under the age of 13: For data protection reasons their parent/guardian should register them with the CAA. The child must still take a **flyer ID** test if they do not have a minimum qualifying 'A' certificate .
